Details will be stored in accordance with current Data Protection legislation for 12 months after Sex, Drugs & Scotland's Health virtual conference (19<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup> October 2021). The information you provide us on registration will not be shared with third parties. Exceptions are listed below:

1. Name, affiliation, research interests and talk details will be published in the conference programme, which will be distributed to all delegates and published online.
2. Name, email address and affiliation will be held by HIV Scotland keeping you informed about the planning of the conference. HIV Scotland will share this information with a number of secure third parties in order to fulfil your order. This includes:
  - Eventbrite – Event Registration Platform
  - Airmeet- Virtual Platform for the Virtual Conference
  - Salesforce - Our Order Processing System
  - MailChimp - Our Email Communication System

3. HIV Scotland will administer post event evaluation survey on behalf of Dundee & Angus Convention Bureau. No identifiable information is required to complete post event evaluation survey.
4. Name, email address and affiliation will be held by the conference organisers for the purpose of informing you of future conferences and events which may be of interest to you.
5. You can choose to share your email address with third party organisations represented at the virtual conference. To do so you must explicitly consent by registering your interest with virtual exhibitors and sponsors.
6. The organisers base their information-sharing decisions on considerations of the safety and wellbeing of the person and others who may be affected by their actions or by the disclosure of information of criminal nature. In these instances, relevant third parties can be contacted.
