## Reuse, Recycle, Repurpose – Our Materials

- Instead of individual printed programmes, we are using online and displayed programmes at the event.
- We encourage you to bring your own lanyard if you have one.
- We encourage delegates to bring their notebooks and pens or take notes digitally on their mobile devices.
- Our name badges are made of FSC Certified, responsibly sourced, recyclable card and do not require a plastic holder.
- We have selected local suppliers wherever possible to avoid long-distance transport of goods and to support our local community.
- We have worked with our conference venue to select seasonal and regional food for the catering and arranged ordering in advance to reduce food waste.

## We ask our sponsors, partners, and visitors to

- Use recyclable or reusable materials wherever possible.
- Use digital communication instead of flyers when possible.
- Consider analysing the carbon footprint associated with your travel to and from Dundee by using this [calculator](#), and compensating for unavoidable emissions through acknowledged carbon offset projects, see [The UN Carbon Offset Platform](#).
